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### Event Weighting

Each round of the Triple Crown State Titles Series will carry an individual weighting allocation as follows:

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### Series Leaderboard

The series leaderboard will be hosted on Bodyboarding Victoria's LiveHeats account and will be accessible to all competitors at all times.



### Series Winners – Triple Crown

The series winner for each division in the Triple Crown Series will be determined by the cumulative total of all three rounds.

### State Champions – State Titles

The State Champions for each division in the State Titles Series will be determined by the cumulative total of a competitor’s best two event rankings after all three rounds have been completed.

### Nationals Side Selection

The composition of the Victorian Nationals team will be determined based on the allocation provided by Surfing Australia.

- The **State Title winner** for each division will receive the **first selection**.
- Remaining spots will be allocated according to the division rankings (e.g., 2nd place receives the next selection, 3rd place follows, etc.).
